Series: Peter – A Character Study

Sermon: From Fisherman to Fisher of Man

Luke 5:1-11

1. Of what do you think when you think of holiness? How do you describe “holy?”
 2. Read Isaiah 6:1-5. According to this passage, what, if any, effect on us is there from seeing God’s glory? Can you think of other Scripture to emphasize this?
 3. Does God’s holiness expose our sin?
 4. Look at Peter’s response to Jesus’ statement about going into deep water. Describe Peter’s irreverence and explain it. Do you ever see this in others? Do you ever see this in yourself?
 5. Had Peter already heard of and met Jesus prior to this Luke 5 incident? If so, what does it say about Peter’s perception of Jesus prior to fish miracle?
 6. Describe the change and the reason for the change in the pre-fish miracle Peter and the post-fish miracle Peter. Why did the fish miracle so impact him?
 7. Where was Peter when he fell to Jesus’ feet? What was the point of Peter falling to Jesus’ feet? Why did God want us to know this happened in the boat?
 8. In a sense, Peter (and mankind) didn’t want Jesus around him prior to the fish miracle. Then, as a result of the fish miracle, Peter doesn’t want Jesus near him. What are the differences between these... why didn’t Peter care for Jesus’ presence prior to the miracle, then after the miracle? Is it the same reason? If not, why did Peter tell Jesus to “go away” in the boat?
