John 6:1-71

- 1. This is a long chapter. Review it and note the major sections, recurring themes/words/ events. Try to notice a flow. What do you see?
- 2. Do you see any resemblance between the feeding of the thousands, this first time, and Moses feeding the Hebrews? What are the similarities and differences?
- 3. Explain how the feeding of the thousands was a noticeable miracle to the thousands who were fed.
- 4. Why do the people follow Jesus across the sea?
- 5. What does Jesus mean by calling Himself "The Bread of Life?"
- 6. In this long chapter the terms "eternal" and "forever." Do they mean the same thing? If not, how are the different?
- 7. What should we learn from those "disciples" who follow Jesus for a time and then leave? Who or what did they reject? Explain. Do we have a right to reject what Christ teaches, even if it goes against our deepest held beliefs?
- 8. Why does Jesus ask "the twelve" if they, too, want to leave?
- 9. In light of this chapter, what is a true disciple? Search the Scripture for Jesus' own words concerning true disciples.
