Romans 12:9-21

1. What makes Romans 12:9-16 so challenging? Is there anything about your personal context that increases the challenge?
2. What would it look like at Grace Mesa for us to “outdo one another in showing honor”? How might YOU put this into practice immediately?
3. What is “hospitality” and how can you pursue it? How can Grace Mesa pursue this concept?
4. Why is it important for us to live in light of the coming day of the Lord? What practical difference could it make in your day-to-day life (in view of this passage)?
5. What does Paul say about retaliation in Romans 12:17-21? How is his teaching countercultural today? How can a belief in God’s final judgment help you leave vengeance to God?
6. What would it look like for your life to be marked by grace and goodness, not vengeance and vitriol?
7. How can you overcome evil with good today?
8. If following Romans 12:9-21 seems impossible, it may be on our own in our own power. Explain how following Romans 12:9-21 reflects Romans 12:1-3.
