There are other sources for information, but be aware that commentaries are someone's opinion, idea or interpretation. Read and understand the Scripture passage first, then you will be better able to discern fact or fiction.

Definitions:

- Event: a thing that happens, especially one of importance, an occurrence
- Depiction: a representation in words or images of someone or something
- Symbol: a symbol is a mark, sign or word that indicated or is understood as representing an idea, object or relationship
- Parable: a simple story used to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson
- Allegory: a story, poem, or picture that can be interpreted to reveal a hidden meaning, typically a moral
- Analogy: a comparison between two things, typically for the purpose of explanation or clarification
- Literal: exactly what is written, you can hold a talent of gold
- Figurative: something does not the exact primary, you can't hold the talent of dancing in your hand
