Sermon: Send Me! Rightly Responding to the

Holiness of God Isaiah 6:1-9

- 1. Does Jesus' reign during times of instability and uncertainty, whether economic or political, give you confidence during such difficult times? Is there a specific situation when you have seen the Lord reigning during a difficult time in your life?
- 2. I love Isaiah's words, "I saw the Lord seated high and lifted up." Explain how we can "see" the Lord high and lifted up through His Word. Should this cause worship or inhibit it? If worship is not occurring, what is the problem?
- 3. Why did the seraphim hide their faces and feet before Jesus?
- 4. What does the word "holy" mean? Why is it stated 3 times by the seraphim?
- 5. How did the image described in Isaiah 6 impact Isaiah? How did it make him view personal sin? How does this contrast with Uzziah's view of himself standing in the Holy Place?
- 6. Does the burning coal represent Christ? If so, how?
- 7. Describe the process by which Isaiah was called. How is this call unique to Isaiah? How is this call similar to ours?
- 8. Why was it important that Isaiah was cleansed before he could be called? Are we saved by good works or to do good works?
- 9. Read Isaiah 6:9-13. What is God doing and why? Why is it important to measure our obedience to God's call simply by obedience, and not by apparent success?
