Revelation 21:1-8

1. As we begin to look at this passage what is the difference between “recreating” and “refurbishing” the earth?
2. In Isaiah 65:17b what is meant by “...the former things will not be remembered or come to mind.”
3. Verse 1 says, there will no longer be any sea, what does the “sea” represent in the bible?
4. In verse 2 we see the “New Jerusalem” what is it, and who will abide in it? Look at John 14:2 for additional insight.
5. What is the importance of verse 3?
 - a. Who will be among men?
 - b. Who makes it possible for God to dwell among men?
6. There will be no more tears in heaven, why? Vs. 4.
7. Who is the Alpha and Omega in verse 6
 - a. And what does He give to lose who thirst? (Isa, 55:1)
8. Verses 7-8 describe two people groups, who are they and what separates them? And what will be the final destination?
