**Sermon: The Truth Is Out There**

**Mark 4:35-41**

1. Why does Pastor Robert consider the event described in Mark 4:35-41 a “Pop Test?”
2. What does it suggest that Jesus led them into this storm? Is this comforting or disconcerting? Explain.
3. Why did the disciples not ask Jesus to calm the storm?
4. How *could* the disciples have responded to the fact that Jesus was sleeping soundly in the boat during the storm? Why did they react the way they did? How does this help us as we face our own mortality?
5. When you read what the disciples said to Jesus in their fear and lack of understanding, can you think of any time(s) you felt like Jesus didn’t care about you and your plight? Is Jesus ever really indifferent?
6. Of what or whom were the disciples “mega” afraid in this event? Why?
7. How is the lesson “Jesus calms the storms of life” an inadequate interpretation of this event? What is the greater lesson?
8. Be painfully honest with yourself in answering the following questions. First, are you “satisfied” with what / how much you know about God? In other words, do you think you know enough? Secondly, do you think Christ is satisfied with what / how much you know? Hasn’t He revealed more? And, because He has revealed more than you presently know, doesn’t He want you to know more?
