Sermon: Parting Unbelief

Numbers 13-14

1. Whose report will you believe? How do we choose to trust God's promise over the intimidating "giants" (obstacles) we see in our lives?
2. Are you viewing challenges from a "grasshopper's" perspective? When we focus on our own weakness rather than God's strength, how does it distort our perception of reality?
3. What is "another spirit?" What does it mean to "follow the Lord fully" like Caleb, possessing a spirit of faith rather than doubt?
4. How does fear paralyze? In what ways do we, like the Israelites, allow fear to make us refuse the blessings God has already given us?
5. Is God's presence enough? When facing the wilderness, do we believe that God's presence is sufficient to sustain us, even without immediate, visible victory?
6. How does the majority influence your faith? When everyone else is retreating in fear, do we have the courage to stand alone with the minority report of faith?
7. What happens when you forget past provision? How does forgetting God's past faithfulness cause us to doubt His ability to handle present difficulties?
8. How do you handle consequences? When disobedience leads to a 40-year "wandering," how does God still show grace while enforcing consequences?
9. Are you waiting for the perfect time? Do we let "giants in the land" stop us from acting on God's call, waiting for a situation that requires no faith?
10. What is the cost of unbelief? How does the story warn us that a lack of faith can result in missing out on the abundant life God intended for us?
