**Sermon: Here Comes the Son
Luke 19:28-44**

1. Read the parable about the minas, immediately preceding the events of Luke 19:28-44. What is the point of this parable? How does it relate to Luke 19:28-44 and following?
2. Why did Jesus ride into Jerusalem on a donkey, instead of a horse? Why does Luke tell us the donkey was a "colt" and what is the significance?
3. What is "peace" and how was Jesus offering it in Luke 19:28-44? Where, in what or in whom did the people think they would find "peace," instead of in Jesus?
4. How do the crowd's praises in Luke 19:38 reflect Psalm 118:26 and what does that reveal about their expectations of a Messiah?
5. Why did the Pharisees demand that Jesus rebuke his disciples? What is the significance of Jesus' response to them?
6. What is the significance of Jesus weeping over Jerusalem in Luke 19:41, rather than celebrating His arrival?
7. What is the prophecy Jesus speaks about Jerusalem in Luke 19:43-44? Explain when this happened and why it is significant?
8. The phrase in Luke 19:42 is, "this day." How does this relate to the 70 Weeks prophecy in Daniel?
9. What "peace" is Jesus trying to bring to your life right now that you might be overlooking? Does Jesus have "control" of you and your obedience, like He did that colt?
