**Series: The King, The Cross and The Empty Tomb**

**Sermon: Alive!**

**Luke 24:1-12**

1. Describe how the women's reactions, then the disciples' reactions, displayed their fear and unbelief?
2. The angel asks, "Why do you seek the living among the dead?" What are some of the "tombs" or dead places we mistakenly look for life, joy, or security today?
3. The women grieved to be reminded of what Jesus told them. How does "remembering His words" change our perspective on current circumstances? If "remembering His words" is important, how important is hearing/ reading His words in order to remember?
4. Explain why it is important that women were the first witnesses to the resurrection? How does this elevate the value of women from the cultural norm of the first century? Can you think of any other example of minimized people being valued witnesses to Jesus?
5. How does the reality of the empty tomb and the resurrected body of Jesus provide assurance for our own resurrection and eternal life?
6. How should Jesus' resurrection and the assurance of our own resurrection influence the way we live?
7. Do you see any change in the disciples after Jesus' resurrection? Describe their whereabouts and feelings after Jesus' arrest and compare it to their whereabouts and behavior after they see Him resurrected.
8. In a world focused on "the here and now," how does the resurrection offer different kind of hope? How can you share with someone this week that "the worst thing is not the last thing."
