Sermon: Strike!

Daniel 2:1-49

1. Reflect on Daniel's response to the situation in Daniel 2, as well as to the people reporting the situation and King Neb, who created the situation. Now, read Luke 6:43-45 and talk about what these responses reveal.
2. What does Daniel's response reveal about his faith and character? Did Daniel include God in his consideration of the situations. Explain your answer.
3. Be honest, what role does prayer play in your response to difficult situations? How can you rely on God so that prayer is your first impulse, rather than a reaction in the flesh?
4. Discuss how the stone from King Neb's dream could be about both Christ's first and second comings.
5. How did Daniel respond to the praise directed at him? How should we respond to praise?
6. List the empires the different elements of the statue represent. Discuss what it means that God not only revealed King Neb's dream to Daniel, but that God foretold these empires. What is "the time of the gentiles"?
7. Why does God sometimes put his servants in places of high authority? Why does He put them in situation of high difficulty and threat? Tell of a time or situation God put you in.
8. Talk about how not letting Babylon live in you sets up the possibility of God using you to subject Babylon to God's influence.
