Sermon: A Burning Conviction

Daniel 3:1-30

1. Name any situation where you had to show courage to stand your biblical conviction like the 3 Hebrews friends did in this passage?
2. King Neb praised Daniel's God near the end of chapter 2. Look at his words and compare them to his actions in chapter 3. Can you point to his motivations in chapter 2 or how his praise might have been shallow? How can we know when someone's praise and repentance are genuine?
3. These Hebrew friends face great pressure to conform. How does our culture pressure us to conform? To what does our culture try to conform us?
4. Look at the words of these 3 Hebrew friends. Does this passage teach that God will preserve us if our faith is strong enough? How do the words of these 3 friends reflect this?
5. What does it mean to view your life as expendable for the sake of God's kingdom? What did these 3 friends care about more than their lives?
6. LWhen God does not deliver us from dangers, trials, disease or worse, does it mean that He abandoned us? Explain your answer.
7. Why is it important to know your beliefs and values prior to facing such a challenge? How does one come to know their beliefs and values?
8. How are you tempted to react when someone makes accusations or threats toward you? How does knowing your beliefs and values influence your reaction or response?
