Sermon: Timber!
Daniel 4:1-37

1. What is pride? How is pride connected to all other sin?
2. Is it arrogant of God to humble everyone whose pride threatens His glory? Does anyone's pride truly "threaten" His glory? Explain.
3. Can you articulate from Daniel 4 how King Nebuchadnezzar may be a genuine believer?
4. Describe a time when God showed you something troubling to get your attention. How did you respond?
5. Why is speaking the truth in love often so difficult? How does Daniel model this act of grace with Nebuchadnezzar in Daniel 4?
6. How can someone who experiences great success in this world, like Nebuchadnezzar, remain humble? How does this apply to you?
7. What is God showing Nebuchadnezzar in making him animal-like? Demonstrate from Daniel 4 that Nebuchadnezzar needed this and, eventually, got the lesson.
8. How could Nebuchadnezzar have used his kingdom to honor God, instead of stealing God's glory? Nebuchadnezzar was not a believer, at least until the end of Daniel 4. How do we / you steal God's glory, even as believers? How can you use your gifts, talents and successes to serve God, give Him glory?
9. How does Jesus model handling greatness? How has He used His power to serve others?
