Sermon: **Only Have Eyes for...
Matthew 10:24-39**

1. Describe how Jesus sent out the 12 disciples in Matthew 10:1-15. What stands out to you?
2. Describe, from Matthew 10:16-23, the difficulties Jesus describes. This is important: What causes these difficulties? Equally important: Does Jesus suggest these difficulties **may** come or **will** come?
3. According to Matthew 10:24-42, what are the potential fears disciples might have as they begin to follow Christ? How does Jesus dispel these fears?
4. Read Micah 7 and consider its historical context. What caused the differences of opinion, and why did the divisions result within families? How does this relate to the Jesus' words in Matthew 10:24-39?
5. In Matthew 10, Jesus speaks of being like sheep, snakes and doves. What do these mean and how do each of these apply to your current context?
6. Be honest: how does Jesus' teaching in Matthew 10 tempt you to fear or cause anxiety? Are there promises made by Jesus in Matthew 10 that help alleviate your fear and cause greater security and joy?
7. In what situations or contexts have you been afraid to confess Christ? How can you confess Christ in those situations?
